Richard Barberian was born in Fresno, five minutes after his twin sister Dorothy. He has a younger sister Roxy. The family moved to Oakland then to San Francisco where he was raised. After high school, Richard entered the U.S.

Army WWII serving in the Asiatic Pacific earning three bronze stars and other awards for bravery. Richard attended City College of San Francisco, University of California Berkeley, University of San Francisco and Colorado University where he received his Pharmacy, Bachelor of Science, Associate and Registered degrees. He married Penny, and together they had four children: Ellen, Laura, Joan and Richard Jr. He also has two grandchildren, Nicholas and Alexandra. Richard owned and operated the Overland Pharmacy in San Francisco for 38 years. After closing his pharmacy he worked for 12 years at Safeway Pharmacy. He chose Safeway because "I wanted to work in a pharmacy that doesn't have a glass between you and the customer". He enjoyed to have the close connection with his customers.Richard was one of the founding members of NorCal Haven Inc, which was founded in 1982 by small group of individuals. They had a vision of an Armenian Home to care for our seniors. He was a dedicated Board member he continuously strived to get funds to keep NorCal's mission alive. He was able to get grants from Lincy Foundation and from the Trust Estate of Dr. Vahe Ashton. His commitment has enabled NorCal Armenian Services to continue its services and programs to this day. He served as president from 1987 - 1991 and from 1995 - 1999. He also served as vice-president and treasurer. He will be missed sorely.
